

Statutory Notice of the proposed dissolution of Woodhouse College in accordance with the Further and Higher Education Act 1992 Section 33 N

This notice is given by the Corporation of Woodhouse College in accordance with The Sixth Form College Corporations (Publication of Proposals) (England) Regulations 2012, No. 1158.

Woodhouse College hereby give notice in accordance with the provisions of the Further and Higher Education Act 1992 (the Act) as amended by the Apprenticeships, Skills, Children and Learning Act 2009 and the Education Act 2011 of the proposal that Woodhouse College (Woodhouse Road, Finchley, London, N12 9EY) be dissolved and the transfer of the property, rights, assets and liabilities to a new Multi Academy Trust that is currently proposed to be known as Frontier Learning Trust (proposed registered address to be c/o Woodhouse College, Woodhouse Road, Finchley, London, N12 9EY).

Dissolution of Woodhouse College is proposed at the request of the Corporation in order that Woodhouse College, a sixth form college, can be replaced with Woodhouse College, a 16-19 academy. This academy will be part of the new a Multi Academy Trust, currently proposed to be known as Frontier Learning Trust, subject to gaining the appropriate permissions for the creation of the Multi Academy Trust.

The date proposed for the dissolution of Woodhouse College as a sixth form college and the establishment of Woodhouse College as a 16-19 academy is 1 August 2020 or as soon as possible thereafter subject to the appropriate permissions.

All students attending Woodhouse College on the date of dissolution as a sixth form college will continue their education as planned at Woodhouse College as a 16-19 academy.

Woodhouse College provides sixth form education primarily at A Level and principally for 16-18 year old students. There are no plans to change the College's provision.

As of 1 January 2020 the number of full-time 16-18 year old students is 1476, the number of part-time students is 6, and the total number of students is 1482.
