

Economics CAGs

In economics the CAG was created by looking at all the work the student submitted on Markbook over the whole period up to 20th March when the college closed. As per Ofqual instructions we did not consider any work submitted after this date. This gave the department an initial ranking of all students. Adjustments were made to this order based on online discussions between teachers using their professional judgment to make the final ranking reflect what they believe it would have been in the public exams had they been sat. This adjustment was in accordance to the instructions we were given by Ofqual/Department of Education. Some ex-students who were retaking their exams were also placed in the rankings where their teachers believed they would have been given the extra work they had submitted/evidence of revision provided before the 20th March. The ranking list for economics was agreed by all staff members after a significant amount of online discussion and much reflection. All of our work was conducted on excel and via live chat on Zoom. We followed advice given by the college and tried to avoid lots of emails and writing and just commented to each other on the Zoom Conference list that were submitted. As per instructions no videos were made of the discussion. The notes of these discussions made by were handwritten by HoD and later discarded. No electronic minutes were kept.
