

Classical Civilisation CAGs 2020

In recommending CAGs for students due to take their Classical Civilisation exams in the summer of this year, I undertook the following process:

I used quantitative and qualitative data to make a professional judgement that's fair, positive and takes into account not only your performance and ability in the three units taught since September 2018, but also your understanding of individual texts in class activities and work set.

Below are a few examples of the areas I took into consideration (listed in no particular order):

- My professional judgement as an examiner on the quality of your written work and understanding throughout your time studying Classical Civilisation.
- Summer 2019 UCAS exam result
- November 2019 in class mini-mock result
- January 2020 mock result
- Consideration of progress that could've been made during study leave/ revision time across Easter 2020 and the exam period.
- Consideration of how students of similar ability performed in the final exams in previous years.
- Final 30 mark essay of the year (completed in June 2020)

Discussion of these areas, each student's progress in Upper Sixth and their ranking took place with the Director of Curriculum (member of SLT).
